
- **each vehicle operating under this licence carries a certificate of registration which must indicate that the vehicle is owned or leased by CCON METALS INC.;**
- **each vehicle and trailer operating under this licence is insured to transport hazardous waste;**
- **each vehicle and trailer operating under this licence carries a minimum of \$5 million liability insurance coverage; and**
- **each vehicle and trailer operating under this licence is operated by the licensee or an employee of the licensee.**

This licence authorizes the licensee to transport only the following type(s) of hazardous waste:

BATTERIES

This licence supersedes and replaces all previously issued licences. Any changes to the information on this licence, including company name, mailing address or waste type require an amendment to the licence.

This licence is issued subject to the licensee: (i) preparing and maintaining a contingency plan acceptable to the Director for implementation in the event of any spill, release, discharge, abandonment or escape of hazardous waste being handled, transported or stored by the licensee; (ii) writing and passing the appropriate Hazardous Waste Transport Licence test or having an employee write and pass the appropriate test; (iii) preparing and continuing to maintain a security deposit of CAD \$10,000, as required and in a form approved by the Director; and (iv) agreeing that the licensee and its employees and agents shall at all times comply with the provisions of the *Environmental Management Act*, and its respective Regulations, as well as all other terms and conditions of this licence.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This Licence to Transport Hazardous Waste, issued pursuant to Section 10 of the *Environmental Management Act* and Section 45 of the *Hazardous Waste Regulation*, authorizes the company or individual named on the reverse to transport hazardous waste within the province of British Columbia under the stated conditions. These conditions apply to all vehicles and trailers that will operate under this hazardous waste transport licence. In addition, all relevant provisions of the federal *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act*, the provincial *Transport of Dangerous Goods Act* and regulations under both statutes are applicable.

Note that Section 10 of the *Environmental Management Act* and Section 46 of the *Hazardous Waste Regulation* establish the requirement and associated conditions for the use of a manifest for the transportation of hazardous waste. Carriers must complete the part of the manifest that applies to them, and any necessary supporting documents, in the form and manner prescribed by the regulation. Where required, the carrier must also submit copies of the manifest, with supporting documents, to the ministry in the manner described by the regulation.

Under Section 45 of the *Hazardous Waste Regulation* a licence may be suspended or cancelled where a licensee violates the terms of the licence or contravenes the *Environmental Management Act* or a regulation under the Act. Additional enforcement action may also be considered if there is information to suggest that hazardous waste has been transported in non-compliance of the *Environmental Management Act* or a regulation under the Act.

For the purposes of this licence "vehicle" is defined as any device that operates on land, other than exclusively on rail, and is designed to be drawn or propelled by any power, other than muscular power, and includes an air cushion vehicle that operates primarily over land. "Trailer" means a road vehicle that is designed to be drawn behind another road vehicle and to carry individuals or goods and includes a semi-trailer and a chassis trailer.

Re: Issuance of renewed licence

Enclosed is your Licence to Transport Hazardous Waste, issued pursuant to Section 10 of the *Environmental Management Act* (EMA) and Section 45 of the Hazardous Waste Regulation (HWR). This licence authorizes your firm to transport hazardous waste within the province of British Columbia under the conditions stated on the licence. Please note these conditions, as they apply to all vehicles and/or trailers that will operate under your hazardous waste transport licence. In addition, you should be aware of all relevant provisions of the *Federal Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act*, the provincial *Transport of Dangerous Goods Act* and regulations under both statutes.

You should note that, under the Hazardous Waste Regulation, a licence may be suspended or cancelled where a licensee violates the terms of the licence or contravenes the *Environmental Management Act* or a regulation under the Act. Licences have expiry dates; carriers that do not have a valid licence are not authorized to transport hazardous waste in British Columbia.

Please be advised that **this licence does not authorize the storage of hazardous waste**; a separate authorization must be issued for such storage. Effective April 1, 2009, the definitions of “temporary storage”, “short-term storage” and “long-term storage” were deleted, in favour of a re-defined “storage”. Consequently, the provisions for temporary storage no longer appear in the regulation. If you intend to store hazardous waste, please contact your nearest Regional Environmental Protection Office for more information on the regulatory requirements for storage.

For your information, the Ministry prepared a Manual for Completing British Columbia's Hazardous Waste Manifests and Supplementary Forms which will be useful to anyone dealing with transportation of hazardous waste in BC.
